Christ in You the Hope of Glory

Colossians 1 v 27

...to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

The word of God says:

I am overtaken with blessings.

Deuteronomy 28 v 2

All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you obey the Lord your God...

Ephesians 1 v 3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ...

I am His disciple because I have love for others.

John 13 v 34-35

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.

I am the salt of the earth.

Matthew 5 v 13

"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men.

I am the light of the world.

Matthew 5 v 14

You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden...

I am the righteousness of God.

2 Corinthians 5 v 21

He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

1 Peter 2 v 24

...and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

Who am I in Christ?

I am a partaker of His divine nature.

2 Peter 1 v 4

For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

I am called of God.

2 Timothy 1 v 9

..who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity...

I am the first fruits among His creation.

James 1 v 18

In the exercise of His will He brought us forth by the word of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

I am chosen.

1 Thessalonians 1 v 4

...knowing, brethren beloved by God, His choice of you...

Ephesians 1 v 4

...just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love.

1 Peter 2 v 9

but you are a chosen race a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who has called you out of darkness into his marvellous light...

I am an ambassador for Christ.

2 Corinthians 5 v 20

Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

I am God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus for good works.

Ephesians 2 v 10

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

Who am I in Christ?

I am the apple of my Father's eye.

Psalm 17 v 8

Keep me as the apple of the eye; Hide me in the shadow of Your wings

I am being changed into His image.

2 Corinthians 3 v 18

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

Philippians 1 v 6

For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

I am God's child for I have been born again.

1 Peter 1 v 23

...for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God.

I am forgiven of all my sins.

Ephesians 1 v 7

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

I am a new creature. The temple of the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 6 v 19

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?

I am delivered from the power of darkness and translated into God's kingdom.

Colossians 1 v 13.

For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Who am I in Christ?

I am redeemed from the curse of the law.

Galatians 3 v 13

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree."

I am blessed.

Deuteronomy 28 v 1-6

"Now it shall be, if you diligently obey the Lord your God, being careful to do all His commandments which I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you obey the Lord your God: "Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country. "Blessed shall be the offspring of your body and the produce of your ground and the offspring of your beasts, the increase of your herd and the young of your flock. "Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. "Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out.

Galatians 3 v 9

So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer.

I am a saint.

Romans 1 v 7

...to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called as saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 1 v 2

To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, saints by calling, with all who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, their Lord and ours.

Philippians 1 v 1

To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, including the overseers and deacons.

I am the head and not the tail.

I am above only and not beneath.

Deuteronomy 28 v 13

The Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you only will be above, and you will not be underneath, if you listen to the commandments of the Lord your God, which I charge you today, to observe them carefully...

Who am I in Christ?

I am holy and without blame.

Ephesians 1 v 4

...just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love...

I am established to the end.

1 Corinthians 1 v 8

...who will also confirm you to the end, blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I am brought close by the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 2 v 13

But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

I am victorious.

Revelation 21 v 7

He who overcomes will inherit these things, and I will be his God and he will be My son.

I am set free.

John 8 v 31 - 32.

So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

I am strong in the Lord.

Ephesians 6 v 10.

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.

I am dead to sin.

Romans 6 v 1-2 and 11

What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase? May it never be! How shall we who died to sin still live in it?

Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

I am more than a conqueror.

Romans 8 v 37

But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.

Who am I in Christ?

I am a joint heir with Christ.

Romans 8 v 16-17

The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

I am sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise.

Ephesians 1 v 13

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise...

I am in Christ Jesus by His doing.

1 Corinthians 1 v 30

But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption...

I am accepted in the beloved.

Ephesians 1 v 6

...to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

I am made complete by Him.

Colossians 2 v 10.

...and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority...

I am crucified in Him.

Galatians 2 v 20

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

I am alive with Christ.

Ephesians 2 v 5

...even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)...

Who am I in Christ?

I am free from condemnation.

Romans 8 v 1

Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

I am reconciled to God.

2 Corinthians 5 v 18

Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation...

I am qualified to share in His inheritance.

Colossians 1 v 12

...giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

I am firmly rooted.

Colossians 2 v 7

...having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude.

I am no longer a stranger.

Ephesians 2 v 19

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household...

I am built up.

Ephesians 2 v 20

...having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone...

I am born of God.

1 John 5 v 18

We know that no one who is born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.

Who am I in Christ?

I am raised up with Christ.

Colossians 2 v 12

...having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

Ephesians 2 v 6

...and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus...

I am beloved of God.

Colossians 3 v 12

So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience...

Romans 1 v 7

...to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called as saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 1 v 4

...knowing, brethren beloved by God, His choice of you...

I am one in Christ.

John 17 v 21-23

...that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me. The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me.

I am persistent.

Philippians 3 v 14

I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

I have the mind of Christ

1 Corinthians 2 v 16

For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he will instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

Who am I in Christ?

I have obtained an inheritance.

Ephesians 1 v 11

...also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will...

I have access to the Father.

Ephesians 2 v 18

...for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father.

I have overcome the world.

1 John 5 v 4 - 5.

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

I have everlasting life and will not be condemned.

John 5 v 24

Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

John 6 v 47

Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life.

I have the peace of God which passes all understanding.

Philippians 4 v 7

And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Who am I in Christ?

I have received power, to lay hands on the sick and see them recover, to cast out demons, and nothing shall hurt me.

Luke 10 v 17 and 19

The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name."

Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you.

Mark 16 v 17 - 18

These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues, they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

I live by and in the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8 v 2

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.

I walk in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 2 v 6

Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him...

I can do all things in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4 v 13

I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.

My life is hidden with Christ in God.

Colossians 3 v 3

For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

I shall do even greater works than Christ Jesus.

I shall possess the greater One in me because greater is He who is in the world.

1 John 4 v 4

You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.

Who am I in Christ?

I always triumph in Christ.

2 Corinthians 2 v 14

But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and manifests through us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in every place.

I show forth His praise.

1 Peter 2 v 9

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvellous light...
